

CONTEST RULES

The Weight of Duty Memorial Match Sticker Contest

The Weight of Duty Memorial Match Sticker Contest (the “**Contest**”) begins on **August 28, 2026**, and ends on **September 20, 2026 at 3:00 p.m. Eastern Time** (the “**Contest Period**”).

The Contest is sponsored by **Dunnville District Hunters & Anglers Club** (the “**Contest Sponsor**”) in connection with the Weight of Duty Memorial Match fundraiser.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER.

Entry in the Contest constitutes acceptance of the terms, conditions and provisions set out below.

1. HOW TO ENTER

1.1

Eligible individuals may enter the Contest in any one of the following ways:

To purchase official Weight of Duty Memorial Match stickers online, an entrant must complete a purchase through the Zero Signature online store at:

(a) Sticker Entry

Purchase official Weight of Duty Memorial Match stickers at the following prices:

- **One (1) sticker for \$30**, which includes **one (1) complimentary Contest entry**; or
- **Three (3) stickers for \$80**, which includes **three (3) complimentary Contest entries**.

Each complimentary Contest entry will have an equal chance of winning.

There is **no limit on the number of stickers an eligible individual may purchase or Contest entries they may receive**, subject to these Contest Rules.

Sticker purchases may be made:

Online: through the Zero Signature online store at <https://zerosig.ca/products/weight-of-duty-memorial-match-2026-sticker> until September 17, 2026 at 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time; or

In person: at the Weight of Duty Memorial Match at the Dunnville District Hunters & Anglers Club from **September 18 through September 20, 2026**, until **3:00 p.m. Eastern Time on September 20, 2026**.

An online sticker entry will be considered complete and eligible once the corresponding purchase has been successfully completed through the Zero Signature online store. Online sticker purchases completed after the online entry deadline will not be eligible for Contest entry.

Shipping or pickup options for online sticker purchases will be provided through the Zero Signature online store, where available.

(b) No-Purchase Entry

To enter without making a purchase, write a **handwritten 1,000-word essay** on the following topic:

“What does standing behind those who serve - and the families they leave behind - mean to you?”

and submit the essay to the Contest Sponsor at:

Each eligible handwritten 1,000-word essay received by the Contest Sponsor will provide **one (1) Contest entry**.

Each essay must be the entrant's original work and must be materially different from any other essay submitted by that entrant. Typed, photocopied, mechanically reproduced, computer-generated or substantially duplicated essays will not be accepted.

Each no-purchase entry must include the entrant's full name, mailing address, telephone number and email address.

No-purchase entries must be **received by the Contest Sponsor no later than September 17, 2026 at 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time**. The date of mailing will not constitute the date of receipt.

1.2 Entry Deadlines

The applicable Contest entry deadlines are as follows:

Online sticker entries: September 17, 2026 at **11:59 p.m. Eastern Time**.

No-purchase entries: Must be received by September 17, 2026 at **11:59 p.m. Eastern Time**.

In-person sticker entries: September 20, 2026 at **3:00 p.m. Eastern Time** at the Weight of Duty Memorial Match.

All eligible entries received by the applicable deadline will be included in the final random draw.

2. THE PRIZES

2.1

The Prize(s) consist of the following:

1 x Derya TM22 Flash 18" Black

1 x Derya TM22 12" Pro Black

1 x Derya TM22 12" Pro Black

1 x NitroFire VAPR Twist .50 Cal 26" Barrel Black/Premium CeraKote Finish with 3-9x40 Scope

Some Prize items may be substituted for other items of similar or greater value based on availability.

2.2

The total approximate retail value of all Prize(s) is **\$2,200.00 CAD**.

2.3

The odds of winning any individual Prize depend on the total number of eligible entries received.

Each eligible entry will have an equal chance of being selected.

2.4 Draw

A separate random draw will be conducted for **each Prize** on **September 20, 2026**, following the close of in-person entries at **3:00 p.m. Eastern Time**.

Each draw will be made from all eligible entries received by the applicable Contest entry deadlines.

The draws will be conducted by **Dunnville District Hunters & Anglers Club** using **Random.org or another verifiable random-selection method**.

One eligible entry will be selected for each Prize.

Winning an individual Prize does not remove an entrant or any of that entrant's remaining eligible entries from subsequent Prize draws. An entrant may therefore win more than one Prize.

The selected entrant for each Prize will be notified by email and/or telephone. Up to three attempts will be made to contact each selected entrant.

If a selected entrant cannot be contacted, is not eligible, fails to correctly answer the required skill-testing question, cannot lawfully receive the applicable Prize, or otherwise does not comply with these Contest Rules, another eligible entry will be randomly selected for that Prize.

2.5

To claim a Prize, each selected entrant will be required:

- (a)** to correctly answer, without assistance, a mathematical skill-testing question;
- (b)** to sign and return a release of liability releasing the Contest Sponsor, its affiliates, partners and organizations involved in the administration of the Contest, and their respective directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, volunteers, successors and assigns, from liability in connection with the Contest or the acceptance, possession or use of the Prize;
- (c)** to sign and return a declaration or certificate of eligibility confirming that the selected entrant is eligible to participate and has complied with these Contest Rules; and
- (d)** where the Prize includes a firearm, to provide satisfactory evidence that the selected entrant is legally entitled to receive the firearm and to complete all transfer requirements imposed by applicable law.

2.6

The Prize must be accepted as awarded. The Prize is not transferable or convertible into cash.

No transfer, substitution or conversion of the Prize will be permitted except as expressly provided in these Contest Rules or at the discretion of the Contest Sponsor where the

intended Prize becomes unavailable for reasons beyond the reasonable control of the Contest Sponsor.

2.7

Except as expressly represented or warranted, the Prize is provided to the winner “as is” without any additional or further representation or warranty of any kind.

2.8

All taxes, fees, shipping charges, transfer costs, permit fees, registration fees or other costs associated with acceptance or receipt of the Prize are the sole responsibility of the Prize winner unless expressly stated otherwise.

2.9

The Contest Sponsor reserves the right to substitute a Prize with another prize of equal or greater approximate retail value if the intended Prize becomes unavailable for reasons beyond the reasonable control of the Contest Sponsor.

3. ELIGIBILITY

3.1

The Contest is open only to legal residents of Canada and is void where prohibited by law.

3.2

Participants must be **eighteen (18) years of age or older** at the time of entry.

3.3

Directors, officers, employees and volunteers of the Contest Sponsor and the organizations presenting or administering the Weight of Duty Memorial Match, together with their immediate family members and persons with whom any of the foregoing are domiciled, are not eligible to enter.

For purposes of these Contest Rules, “immediate family” means a spouse, parent, child or sibling, whether or not residing in the same household.

For purposes of these Contest Rules, the presenting organizations are:

Prize suppliers and any individuals directly involved in the administration, operation or random draws associated with the Contest are also not eligible to enter.

3.4 Firearm Prizes

Where a Prize includes a firearm and the Prize is to be transferred to an individual, the selected entrant must hold a valid Canadian firearms licence authorizing the entrant to acquire and possess the applicable firearm and must satisfy all other requirements imposed by applicable law.

The selected entrant must provide any licence, identification or other documentation required to complete the lawful transfer of the firearm.

No firearm will be transferred unless and until all applicable legal requirements, transfer procedures and verifications have been completed.

If a selected entrant cannot lawfully receive the applicable firearm Prize, the entrant will be disqualified from receiving that Prize and another eligible entry will be randomly selected for that Prize.

Any costs associated with licensing, authorization, transfer, shipping or other legal requirements are the responsibility of the winner unless expressly stated otherwise.

3.5

A selected entrant must correctly answer a mathematical skill-testing question in order to be declared a winner and receive a Prize.

4. GENERAL PROVISIONS

4.1

By submitting an entry or claiming a Prize, the participant agrees to be bound by all of the terms, conditions and provisions set out in these Contest Rules.

4.2

The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations.

4.3

All decisions of the Contest Sponsor, and any judge or judges appointed by the Contest Sponsor, with respect to any aspect of the Contest will be final and binding, subject to applicable law.

4.4

The Contest Sponsor accepts no liability arising in respect of participation in the Contest by any individual or the awarding, acceptance or use of any Prize except to the extent that such liability cannot lawfully be excluded.

4.5

A total of **four (4) Prize(s)** will be awarded.

4.6

The identity of confirmed Contest winner(s) may be announced through the Weight of Duty Memorial Match website, social media channels or other communications following confirmation of the winner(s).

4.7

All entries and Prize claims become the property of the Contest Sponsor and will not be returned.

Handwritten essays submitted through the no-purchase method of entry will not be returned.

4.8

All entries are subject to verification.

Any entry that is incomplete, illegible, forged, fraudulent, tampered with, altered, reproduced contrary to these Contest Rules, obtained through unauthorized means or otherwise fails to comply with these Contest Rules may be declared void.

4.9

Persons found to be tampering with or abusing any aspect of the Contest, attempting to manipulate the entry or draw process, submitting fraudulent entries or otherwise acting contrary to the spirit or administration of the Contest may be disqualified at the sole discretion of the Contest Sponsor, subject to applicable law.

4.10

If circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the Contest Sponsor materially compromise the fairness, security, integrity or proper administration of the Contest, the Contest Sponsor reserves the right, subject to applicable law, to suspend, delay, modify or terminate the Contest.

5. PRIVACY

5.1

By entering the Contest, entrants consent to the collection, use and disclosure of personal information reasonably necessary to administer the Contest, including for the purposes of:

- (a)** processing and verifying Contest entries;
- (b)** contacting selected entrants;
- (c)** confirming eligibility;
- (d)** administering the random draw;
- (e)** arranging the lawful transfer and delivery of Prizes; and
- (f)** identifying and announcing confirmed Contest winners.

Personal information collected for the Contest will not be used for unrelated marketing purposes unless the entrant separately consents to such use.

5.2

By accepting a Prize, a confirmed winner consents to the reasonable use and disclosure of their name and city and/or province of residence by the Contest Sponsor for the purpose of announcing the winner of the Contest, without additional compensation, except where prohibited by law.

Any additional use of a winner's photograph, likeness, video or other personal information for promotional purposes will be subject to any consent required by applicable law.

6. LIMITATIONS ON LIABILITY

6.1

To the maximum extent permitted by law, the Contest Sponsor, its affiliates, partners, participating organizations, advertising and promotional agencies, Prize suppliers, any judge or judges appointed by the Contest Sponsor, and in each case their respective directors, officers, owners, employees, agents, representatives, volunteers, successors and assigns will not be liable for:

(a) any cost, liability, expense, injury, damage or claim arising in connection with participation in the Contest or resulting from acceptance, possession, transportation, transfer or use of any Prize, including personal injury, death or property damage; or

(b) any incidental, consequential, special or indirect damages arising in connection with the Contest or a Prize, to the extent permitted by law.

Nothing in these Contest Rules limits or excludes liability that cannot lawfully be limited or excluded.

6.2

The Contest Sponsor will not be liable for late, lost, invalid, ineligible, illegible, incomplete, stolen, misdirected, damaged or postage-due entries or Prize claims.

6.3

The Contest Sponsor assumes no responsibility for problems or technical malfunctions involving telephone networks, computer systems, servers, access providers, websites, software, payment processing systems, internet connections or other systems that may prevent an entry or Prize claim from being properly received or recorded.

7. RELEASE

7.1

By entering the Contest, each participant agrees, to the extent permitted by law, to release and hold harmless the Contest Sponsor, its affiliates, partners, participating organizations, advertising and promotional agencies, Prize suppliers, any judge or judges appointed by the Contest Sponsor, and in each case their respective directors,

officers, owners, employees, agents, representatives, volunteers, successors and assigns, from liability arising in connection with participation in the Contest or resulting from the acceptance, possession, transportation, transfer or use of any Prize, including personal injury, death, property damage and claims relating to publicity rights, defamation or invasion of privacy.

8. WEIGHT OF DUTY MEMORIAL MATCH

8.1
